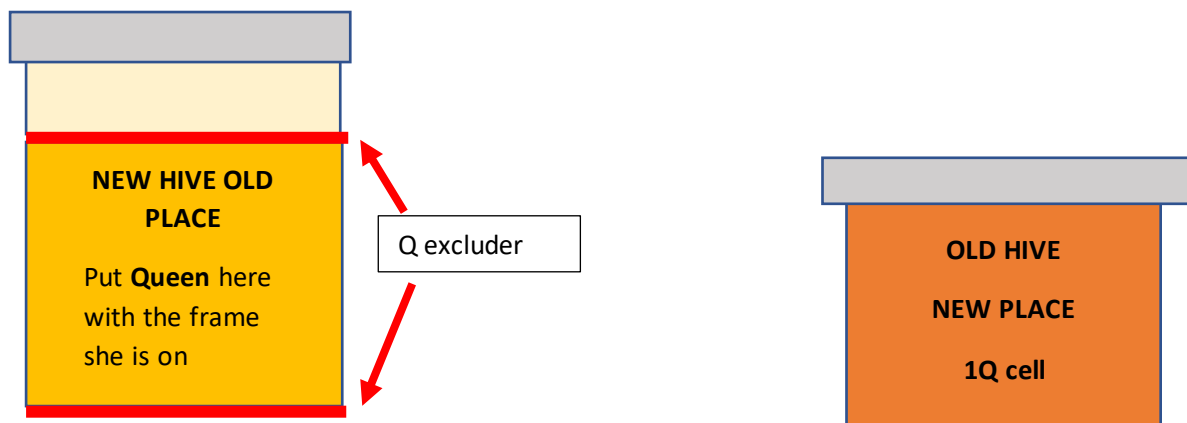
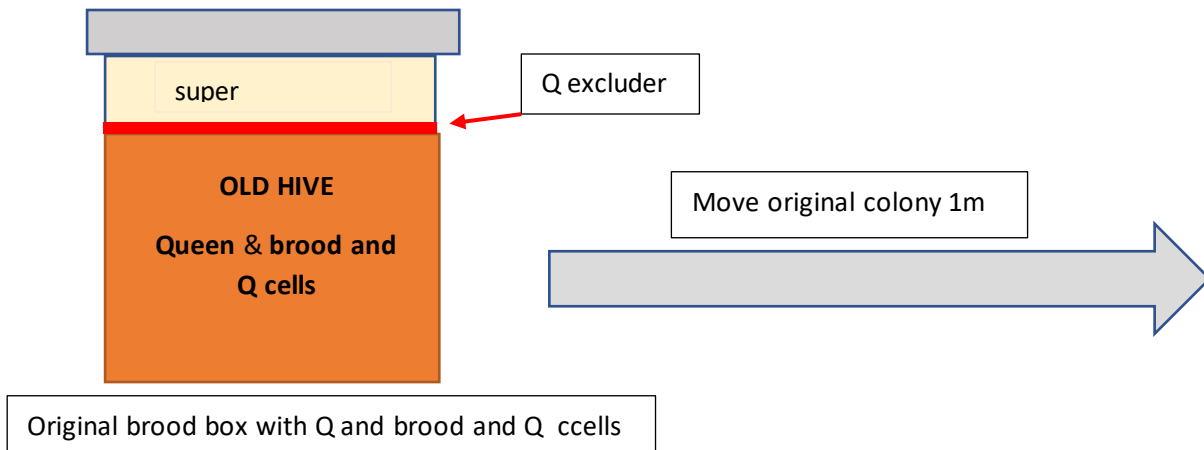


Swarm control

Pagden method.



1. Put new brood box on original site (OLD PLACE) filled with foundation, put a Q excluder under the brood. Super stays on original site (OLD PLACE).
2. Find Q in OLD HIVE and put her and the frame she is on into the NEW HIVE ensure has no Q cells.
 - Flying bees will leave OLD HIVE and join the Q in the NEW HIVE.
 - Conduct normal 7 day inspection there after.

3. in OLD HIVE knock down all queen cells **leaving 1.**
 - On next inspection you can move the original colony to the other site of the new brood box, this will bleed more flying bees to the new brood box
 - Then leave for 3 weeks for the new Q to mate
